Traverse City. As always, *weather permitting*, here is next week's scheduled road work affecting traffic flow.

Holiday Hills Area SAD, Acme Township

- Additional restoration will be performed.
- Lane closures may cause slight delays.

South Airport Road, US-31 to Veterans Drive, Garfield Township

Hammond Road, Garfield and East Bay Township.

Various Peninsula Township County Road and State Highway M-37, Peninsula Township

- Work will continue through the week.
- Durapatching of shoulders.
- Lane closure/lane shifts under flag control.

Timber Trails and North Long Road Intersection, Long Lake Township

- Work began on Monday, October 5, 2015 is expected to last two weeks.
- Developer's contractor will be installing a center left-turn lane.
- Lane closures under flagging operations.

Pavement Marking – Various Locations throughout the County

- Beginning Monday, October 12, 2015 our pavement marking contractor will in Grand Traverse County.
- Fog lines (white outer lines) and center lines (yellow inside lines) will be placed.
- Motorists should reduce speed, obey flaggers and maintain distance from safety barrels to avoid paint splatter.
- Slight delays are anticipated due to temporary lane closures while the paint dries.

Sign Upgrades - Various Locations on North Long Lake Road, Long Lake Township

- Ongoing.
- Sign upgrades along various county roads.
- **Moving operations along road shoulders. *See note below.*

Various Roads in Peninsula Township, Hammond Road in Garfield and East Bay Townships and State Highways

- Work activities include shouldering, ditching and Durapatching operations.
- **Moving operations. *See note below.*

***Moving operations typically do not have "flaggers" directing traffic or work zone signs as work is continuously moving down the road. Motorists should watch for flashing lights on vehicles as warning indications.*

Work on Area Roads by Others

- M-186, M-113 to US-131, Fife Lake Township. Road resurfaced under flag control until October 16.
- US-31/M-37 (Chum's Corner) Blair Township. Concrete patching of right-turn lanes. October 12-15.
- Lautner Road, Acme Township. The detour has been extended to late October 2015. Acme Township.
