Weather permitting, here is the list of scheduled road work for the coming work week affecting traffic flow.

Yuba Road, Acme Township

CLOSED from US-31 to water's edge (open to local traffic only)
 Reconstruction.

Elk Lake Road, Whitewater Township

DETOUR. Route will be north of Hawley, Cram and Palaestrum Roads. (See map.)
 Local traffic only. The road will be closed to thru traffic on Monday, September 26, for one day, weather permitting.

Hammond Road, Edgecomb Road to Three Mile Road, Garfield and East Bay Townships.

Shoulder closure for approximately three weeks.
 Contractor will be installing water and sewer facilities.

Herkner/North Long Lake Road Intersection, Long Lake Township.

Lane closure.
 Utility company will be replacing the power pole at this location. No firm date has been received.

North Summit City Road, Paradise Township

Lane closure all week.
 Gravel road improvements.

US-31 North near Don's Drive In, East Bay Township.

Lane shifts.
 Crews will be repairing joint and culverts failures on both sides of the highway.
 Northbound traffic will be impacted in the morning and Southbound traffic in the afternoon.

Veteran's Drive, north of the Township Hall to the city limits, Garfield Township.

Lane closures on Wednesday, September 28, weather permitting.
 Tree removal will be performed under flagging operations.
