Subject: Veterans Recognized as Honor Flight Memorial Visits Remembered

“It is truly a privilege to be a part of Mid-Michigan Honor Flight,” exclaims Michigan native and United States Air Force Veteran, Beau A. Vore. As the Director of Veterans Outreach for Mid-Michigan Honor Flight, Mr. Vore will share his unique involvement in this special program with area residents at Grand Traverse Commission on Aging Senior Center Network Acme, Kingsley, Interlochen, and Fife Lake Satellite locations, this March (schedule below), recounting first-hand, his experiences with area veterans, as they traveled to Washington D.C., for a day devoted to honor and remembrance. The mid-Michigan Honor Flight program, a part of the national organization – Honor Flight Network, began with a first flight from Grand Rapids, in June of 2014, followed by a first flight for northern Michigan veterans from Traverse City, in September of the same year. Totally supported through donations and staffed by volunteers, Honor Flight truly gives veterans “a once in a lifetime opportunity” to visit their memorial without concerns normally associated with travel, and is completely free of charge. Vore explains, “The men and women who have served America deserve

so much more than any of us can offer. Honor Flight is the best way to express our gratitude for what they gave to ensure our freedoms.” There is no cost to attend presentations; no registration is required.
