Traverse City. Weather permitting, here is the list of scheduled road work activities for the coming week that will affect traffic flow.

North Star Drive, Hammond Road to Birmley Road, Garfield Township.

- Tuesday and Thursday, July 28 and 30. 7:30 AM to 3:30 PM.
- A layer of chip seal (tar-and-chip) will be placed each day.
- Lane closure directed by flaggers. Business traffic only (No cut-through traffic).

Four Mile Road, North of Hammond Road, East Bay Township.

- Weather permitting, through the whole week.
- Installation of center, left-turn lane.
- Intermittent lane closure with traffic directed by flaggers.

Garfield Road, Church Street (Village of Mayfield) to Hobbs Highway, East Bay and Paradise Townships.

- Monday and Tuesday, July 27 and 28.
- Chip sealing.
- Lane closure with traffic directed by flaggers.

Garfield Road, Hobbs Highway to Potter Road, East Bay and Garfield Townships.

- Throughout the week.
- Prep work for chip sealing and chip sealing.
- Lane closure with traffic directed by flaggers.

Various Locations in Whitewater and Paradise Township.

- Throughout the week.
- Adding clay to gravel roads.
- ****Moving operations.**

Various Locations throughout the County.

- Ongoing.
- Sign upgrades along various county roads.
- Completing Hobbs Highway followed by North Long Lake Road.

County Road 633, Wexford County Line to US-31, Grant and Blair Townships.

Cedar Run Road, Benzie County Line to Barney Road, Long Lake and Garfield Townships.

- Throughout the week.
- Projects will receive pavement markings (line painting).
- ****Moving operations**

Work on County Roads by Others

- Lautner Road. Detoured through September 1, 2015. Acme Township.
- Harris Road. Detour due to watermain extension. Garfield Township.

***Moving operations do not have "flaggers" directing traffic as work is continuously moving down the road. Motorists should watch for flashing lights on vehicles as warning indications.*
